A team of local experts will review your item and provide you with a verbal appraisal. Modeled after the popular "Antiques Roadshow" program, each exhibitor will be able to tell their story and the items will be projected on the big screen for all to view.

The fee is \$12.00 per item with a limit of 2 items per person. Registrations begin October 1, 2019. Exhibitors will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, and space is limited, so register early! You will receive a confirmation once your registration has been received and accepted.



#### Becky Knickerbocker donates her Kitchen Utensil Collection to the Minnetonka Historical Society

Petey Ellis, MHS Board Member and one of our Curators for the Burwell Museum, wrote this article about Becky Knickerbocker and her recent donation of dozens of antique kitchen utensils to the Minnetonka Historical Society:

Becky Knickerbocker is a longtime resident of Minnetonka. Becky taught school at Gatewood for 35 years as a kindergarten teacher and 7 years as a preschool teacher at All Saints Church. Becky says "As a young woman I enjoyed collecting antiques. I began a quest of collecting antique cooking utensils. As my collection grew, I was challenged to discover their purpose. I wanted to display them so we put up a bright red molding around our kitchen ceiling and hung them all. Guests loved guessing their purpose and were challenged to find the 1 out of 100 that was not a utensil. I wanted to gift this fun collection but didn't know where. On a tour of the Burwell House, I found a perfect home for my treasures. The museum can display my collection so others will enjoy them too."

What a great summer we have had when we reopened the Minnetonka Historical Society Museum located on the grounds of the Burwell House. This building was once the headquarters of the Minnetonka Mills Company. Over 450 guests came to explore our Museum.

Each month we highlighted a specific history topic. For June, we displayed photos, a time line of events, and artifacts that told the story of Milling on the Minnehaha Creek. For July, we displayed photos and artifacts about berry picking and truck farming in Minnetonka. For August and September, we told the story of Victorian kitchens. We featured unique kitchen utensils made first by tinkers who came to each house selling and making clever items needed by cooks. We also talked about ways to preserve food needed throughout the year. We shook cream into butter and tasted fresh and dried blueberries. Outdoors, our guests were able to wash clothes in the Victorian way. In September we also added a vignette of the three different Burwell Schools in Minnetonka Mills centered around an original student desk and books.

The museum will be opened during the Spooktacular organized by the City of Minnetonka scheduled for October 25 th . We will also have three Victorian Games. You can play Skittles, Pin the Tail on the Donkey, and a Tops Spinning with nearly authentic Victorian candy as the prize for trying. Do come and enjoy a spooky evening. We have been lucky enough to receive several gifts for our Museum. We have received, sketches, an old telephone, plates, maps, a fan collection, and more. If you need a new home for your precious small antique items or pictures, please consider our museum as a new home for your treasures.
